## **Home Generator Safety**

Home generators are useful in a power outage but they can also be very dangerous.

Here's how to stay safe.



Use a battery-operated carbon monoxide detector at home



Keep your generator dry and protected from rain and snow



Do not store fuel in your home, near the generator, or heat-producing appliances



Never use a portable generator indoors, including in a garage



Hard-wired generators require a permit to ensure they are properly installed



Ensure your generator is the right size for your home's load



Plug appliances directly into the generator



Do not overload the generator



Shut down your generator and allow it to cool before refueling







Make sure your generator is properly connected with a CSA-approved transfer switch
