**Course: High Voltage Awareness**

- · What to do and how to report unsafe conditions

- Understand the effects that electricity has on the human body
- Understand the difference between step and touch potential and how to minimize them
- · Identify electrical hazards on and above the ground
- Know who to notify if they identify a hazard
- Know what to do if they come across a hazard
