FORTISALBERTA DONATES MORE THAN \$100,000 FOR ENVIRONMENTAL INITIATIVES IN ALBERTA

May 19, 2021 (FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE) – At FortisAlberta, we believe in contributing to the well-being of the communities where our customers and employees live and work. Through our Community Investment program, we work to empower communities by supporting organizations that offer programs and services that align with four focus areas: safety, education, the environment and wellness.
