Trees are precious to us, but sometimes they pose a safety hazard if they're too close to power lines.

Here's what you need to know:



Take precautions

If you come across a tree that has fallen on a power line, call us immediately. At all times, keep children away from tree limbs that are close to power lines.



Leave the trimming to professionals

Our trimmers are trained in proper techniques and do their best to redirect growth while protecting the health of the tree. If the tree is touching a primary line, we will trim the tree for you. If the tree is touching a secondary line, we will temoprarily disconnect power and we will clear the immediate safety issue if there is one. However, you are still responsible for getting a third party to clear the rest of the tree once we are finished.



Plant with care

Plant trees a minimum of six metres from power lines to accommodate for their full height and wind sway.



Plant a minimum of eight metres away

Give trees

8 metres

of clearance
