

PUBLIC NOTICE

CANADIAN NAVIGABLE WATER ACT

FortisAlberta Inc. hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act for the approval of the work we propose in proximity to the North Saskatchewan River near Fort Saskatchewan, Alberta.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, FortisAlberta Inc. has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the online Navigable Waters Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca>) and under the NPP, File Number 2020-602488 (Registry #1684) – Aerial Cable – North Saskatchewan River, Alberta.

FortisAlberta Inc. is seeking authorization to replace the existing damaged utility poles, installed in the early 1990s. The project involves replacing three, 65-foot and three, 90-foot wooden poles with fiberglass poles that support the existing three-wire 25,000-volt power line that crosses the North Saskatchewan River.

The pole locations are approximately 30 metres from the riverbank and are found in SW-04-55-22-W4 (53o 43' 11.64" N and 113o 12' 43.56" W).

This project is necessary to ensure future electricity reliability, public safety and to preserve the environmental protection of the area.

Comments regarding the effect of this work on marine navigation must be received in writing (by letter or email to the below).

They will only be considered if they are received no later than 30 days after the publication of this notice. Although all comments conforming to the above will be considered, no individual responses will be sent.
